General

Use of the substance / preparation Constructions.

First aid procedures

General	No action is required when handling the product in the condition it is supplied. The first aid measures given below are intended for exposure to dust that arises from the processing of the product. Emergency telephone number: see section 1.4.
Inhalation	Fresh air and rest. Get medical attention if any discomfort continues.
Skin contact	Remove contaminated clothing. Wash with soap and water. Get medical attention if any discomfort continues.
Eye contact	Immediately flush with plenty of water or eyewash solution for up to 10 minutes. Remove contact lenses and open eyes wide apart. Get medical attention if any discomfort continues.
Ingestion	Hardly relevant. Rinse mouth thoroughly. Do not induce vomiting. Get medical attention.
Acute symptoms and effects	Dust may cause mechanical irritation of mucous membranes. Symptoms may include coughing, sore throat, reddening, burning sensation and heavy watering of the eyes Existing respiratory disorders may be aggravated, for example asthma or other chronic respiratory disease. Dust may cause mechanical irritation of the skin. Dust may give mechanical eye irritation.
Other information	No specific information from the manufacturer. Treat symptomatically.

Protective equipment

Additional eye protection measures	Eye wash facilities should be available at the work place. Either a fixed eye wash facility connected to the drinking water (preferably warm water) or a portable disposable unit.
Suitable gloves type	Leather. Textile.
Recommended respiratory protection	Use mask with filter P2 in case of dust formation.,EN 143 (Respiratory protective devices. Particle filters. Requirements, testing, marking). EN 149.

Fire fighting measures

Suitable extinguishing media	Foam, carbon dioxide or dry powder.
Fire and explosion hazards	The product is not classified as flammable. High concentrations of dust may form explosive mixture with air.
Personal protective equipment	Use compressed air equipment when the chemical is involved in fire. In case of evacuation, an approved protection mask should be used. See also section 8.

Preventive Measures to contain emissions

Personal protection measures	Avoid generation and spreading of dust.
Environmental precautionary measures	The product should not be dumped in nature but collected and delivered according to agreement with the local authorities.
Clean up	The product are collected mechanically. Dispose of in accordance with local regulations for waste handling (see section 13).
